

Membership Committee

- Committee will consist of representatives from each chapter, with a Committee chairperson.
- Maintains the Guild Leadership roster.
- Maintains current membership list.
- Work closely with Membership Committee chairperson to assure records are complete and accurate.
- Register new members and assist in the purchasing of memberships.
- Provides membership cards.
- Collects dues on an annual basis.
- Update monthly memberships records and print check which is reconciled quarterly.
- Handle orientation for new chapters.
- Assures confidentiality of data by sharing information with Guild members only. It is strictly prohibited to provide Guild member information for any purpose.

Membership – Addresses:

Membership with the Quilting Guild of the Villages (QGOTV) is open to all residents of The Villages. As a standard practice, a village address for our records must be given as the **primary** address when signing up for membership to QGOTV. Should there be another address you wish the Guild be aware of, it will be considered a secondary address. This does not change whatever primary/secondary address you have set up with your fed/state/local communities. This is simply used for membership eligibility. When moving from one location in The Villages to another, make sure you update your profile address.

Your address information is only available to the member's chapter in which he/she belongs, Chapter and Guild officers and certain committees as appropriate. We do not support and fully discourage the

sale or disbursement of ANY address lists regardless of the reason.
Anyone caught disbursing any such lists will be dealt with by the Guild
Executive Board.
