Your quilt is a surprise gift to a grateful Veteran. A "Thank You for Your Service" from the QGOTV label will be affixed on the back of each quilt by the Honor Flight Coordinator(s). Your labels are welcome, the Veterans' delight is seeing where this quilt was made and who made it.
