

Boys' s Car Mat



I used scrap material that was cut into 4 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles, sewn into a 3 x 4 rectangular configuration.

The mat size is 16" x 18. I should be small enough to use on a lap for children in hospital beds or in wheelchairs.

You can use one piece of material or as many as you want (5" squares.... 4 x 5 or 2 ½ "squares8x9).

Next put the top sheet together. Sandwiched the top with batting and a back. I like flannel backs for children's articles... Then quilt the sandwich.

Apply the "road" after you quilted the piece. I used bias tape as my road. You can use material, bias tape or anything you would like grosgrain ribbon, webbing, etc.

Next bind the mini quilt.

Another suggestion was to place a marble into the channel and sew both beginning and ending down. Then the child would not need a car, but could direct the marble through the maze.
