- Challenge Quilts for AQS display in February 2025 This was voted on last month but there was a discussion as to what challenge options might be:
  - a. All solids
  - b. Flying geese
  - c. Design using the Kona and Pantone color of the year
  - d. Using selvage for a trash to treasures theme
  - e. Using batiks seashore or nature theme
  - f. A theme of home

All ideas were voted on and it was decided that the theme would be home using all solid fabrics, including the binding (color of the year fabrics optional). The size of the quilt would be no less than a perimeter of 48 inches and no more than a

perimeter of 96 inches. The quilt does not have to be a square but must be a size between those perimeters. It was also voted that you could put embellishments on the quilt. There can be one quilt per chapter or if individuals from chapters want to submit a quilt on their own that would be allowed. All entries must be turned in no later than Tuesday August 27th at the Programs meeting.
