At the Executive Board Meeting April 16, 2024 the scholarship committee requested a change in the wording of the scholarship fund as follows:

The Quilting Guild of the Villages (QGOTV) is offering an award of up to \$2,000 to encourage and reward continuing education students who (1) excel in the field of sewing, (2) show commitment to the volunteer sector, and (3) to advance future generations in continued sewing awareness.”
