Only use Active Charity numbers

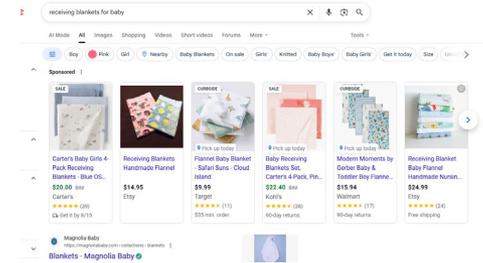

# Inconsistent Valuations

- Suzy Bags one time \$1 next time \$5 – it is \$5
- Pillowcases \$12 or \$15 – it is \$15
- Bibs
- Quilts vs Receiving Blankets
- Quilts vs Knit or Crochet Blankets
- Wheelchair/Chair Lap Quilts vs Blankets
- Free Skechers Drawstring Backpacks should not be entered
- Standardized Valuation Chart review

# Charity Tracker Demo

- Entering data
- Reviewing data entry
- Pulling data for reports – download to Excel
- Quarterly Timeframes
  - Quarter 1 January 1 – March 31
  - Quarter 2 April 1 – June 30
  - Quarter 3 July 1 – September 30
  - Quarter 4 October 1 – December 31

Weekly and monthly data entry is better than last day of the Quarter
